Forum Use Guidelines

Personal Responsibility

All posts, images and attachments are the responsibilities of their owners and not of this site.

Family-friendly Content

This site is intended to be family friendly and we want children to be able to participate. As such keep your content appropriate. Do not post nude or crude photos or graphics, in a post or avatar. Keep your language clean and G-rated. It should be free of sexual inferences, innuendos, and obscenities. Violation of this guideline may result a person being barred from participation.

Posting Etiquette

These forums were created to create a sense of community, have fun and to share information. Be polite and courteous in all your communication. If someone as part of a post reveals they legally kept a fish, do not criticize them for doing so. Catch and release is a personal preference, not the law. If you want to discuss something not directly related to a post, start one yourself. Don't hijack someone else's.

Any posts or subsequent replies, viewed as inappropriate or in violation of these guidelines will be deleted by a moderator. Any member that exhibits a pattern of inappropriateness or violation of these guidelines may result in a person being barred from participation.

Fishing Reports- Spot Identification

Many fishermen, while willing to share details in a fishing report, do not want to identifying their exact spot. That is a personal choice, which needs to be respected. When a spot is identified it is greatly appreciated. We encourage all fishing reports to provide non-spot information such as the date of the report, general location (saltwater) or lake/river (freshwater), lures/bait used, equipment used, depth, etc. The point of a fishing report is to share the experience and as best as possible help others at the same time. If pictures are provided in the reports, blurring revealing backgrounds in photos is ok.

Classifieds

Classified posts should have a way for interested parties to contact the poster. If you are not interested in an item, do not comment on the post.

Business Use of the Forums

Businesses are not free to use this forum to advance their business interests. Members not affiliated with a business that provides fishing services may recommend such businesses, but should do so on a limited basis. if such "recommendations" become excessive it may result in a person being barred from participation.

Reporting Violators

If you see someone breaking these guidelines, use the "Notify" button at the bottom of his post. This triggers an email to all moderators of that forum.
